She is particularly passionate about sound and physical aspect of the music on stage and is the founder of different project in the fields of creation, théâtre musical, electro-acoustic music called Romanesco Duo and Projet Ohr. She took part in festival such as Internationales Musikinstitut Darmstadt, Time of Music Finland, Mixtur Barcelona, Les amplitudes CH, Musik festival Bern...and played with different renowned ensemble and orchestra like Ensemble Modern, IEMA, Eklekto, Ensemble Symphonique de Neuchâtel among other. Besides written repertoire, she very willingly improvise and it's a way for her to make new musical meeting and inspiration. Before her studies in Bern, she studied in the *Conservatoire de Strasbourg* with Emmanuel Sejourné, Denis Riedinger and Stefan Fougeroux where she received her diploma with a high distinction. In 2023 she is the laureate of the Kranischteiner Musikpreis (Stadt Darmstadt). Romane Bouffieux has collaborated with Ensemble Modern, IEMA, We spoke, Polyphorm FINTAQ improvisiert!, Vertigo Ensemble, Eklekto, Soundtrieb, Tramontana...
